Green Bean and Ham Soup

4 cups fresh green beans, trimmed and cut into 1-inch pieces

3 cups russet potatoes, unpeeled and cubed 2 small onions, thinly sliced **3** whole carrots, peeled and sliced

1 pound fully cooked ham, cut into bite-sized pieces

9 cups water

1 teaspoon salt

¼ teaspoon black pepper1 teaspoon garlic powder

1 cup half and half

2 tablespoons corn starch

1/4 cup cold water

Place green beans, potatoes, onions, carrots, ham and the nine cups water into a large soup pot; cover and bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium and simmer, uncovered, about 45 minutes or until the vegetables are tender. Remove the pot from the heat and add the salt, black pepper, garlic powder and half and half. Return to heat and bring to a simmer again. Combine corn starch and

the ¼ cup cold water in a small bowl. When simmer begins, **combine** the corn starch mixture into the soup and stir well. Allow the soup to remain on the heat for 5-7 more minutes while it thickens.

Yield: 12, 1 cup servings

Roasted Root Vegetables

6 medium beets

2 large sweet potatoes

3 parsnips

2 tablespoons olive oil

1 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon black pepper

Dressing (recipe follows)

Dressing

¹/₃ cup white wine vinegar

1/4 cup olive oil

2 tablespoons horseradish

1 tablespoon Dijon mustard

2 teaspoons honey

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

Stir together and set aside.

Preheat oven to 400° F.

Peel beets, sweet potatoes and parsnips. Cut into ½ inch thick cubes.

Toss vegetables with olive oil and place in a single layer on a greased baking sheet.

Sprinkle with salt and pepper.

Bake at 400°F for 20 to 25 minutes, or until tender. Cool. Arrange vegetables on a serving dish and drizzle with dressing.

Yield: 6 servings
